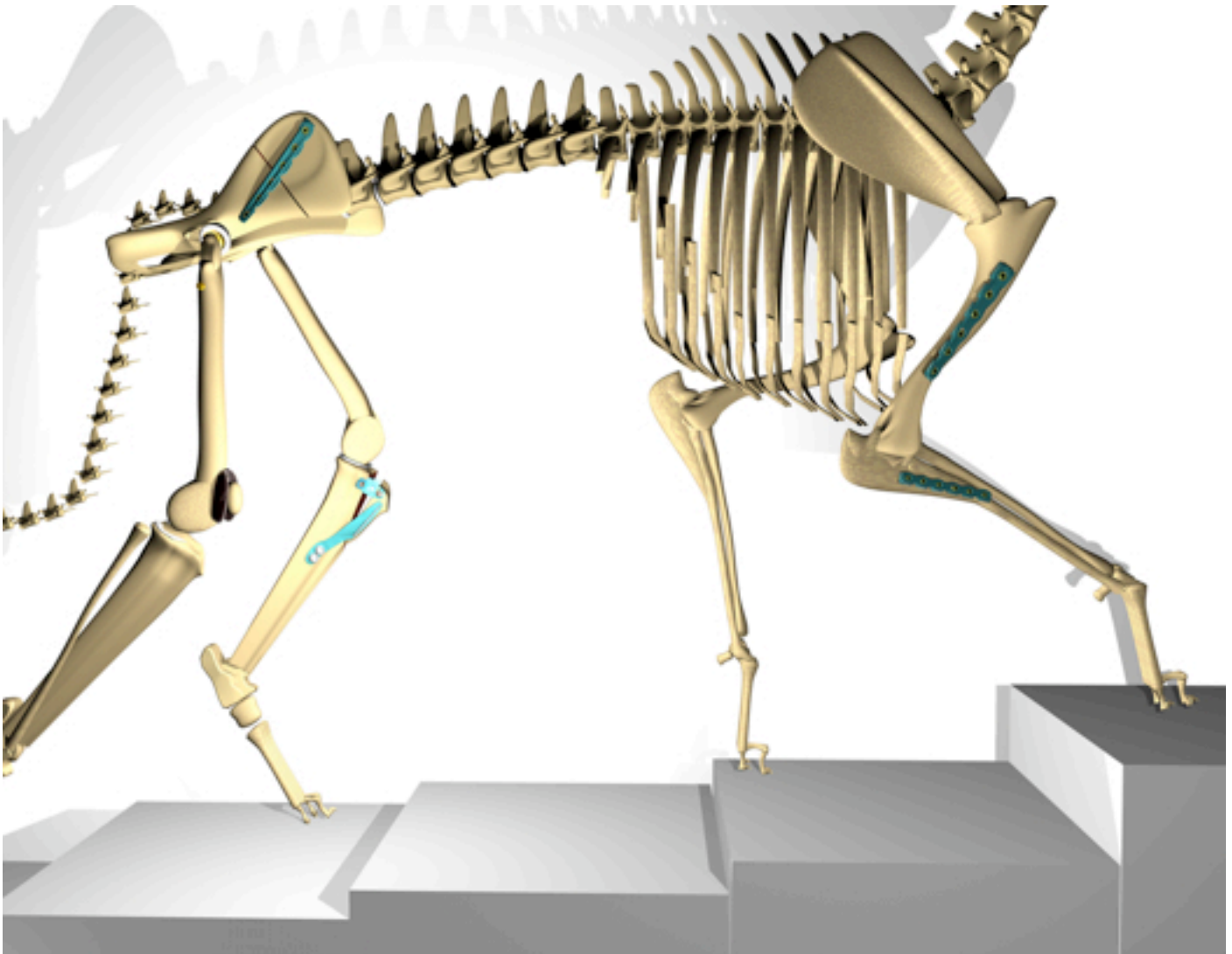

Juvenile Conditions of the Forelimb

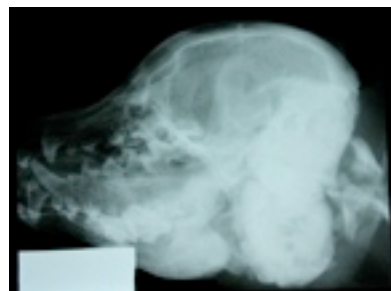

Orthopaedic Instrumentation

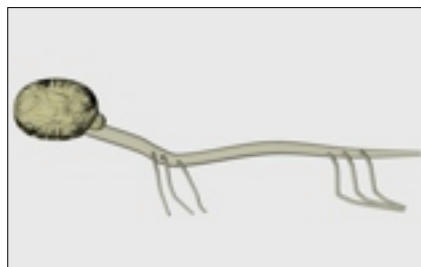

phase. Also includes reference to the use of rehabilitation.



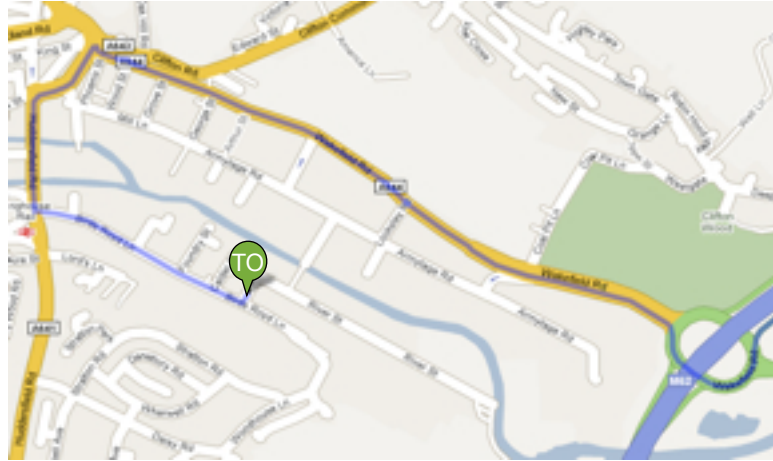
Emergency Case Studies
